# WHAT IS ANALOG FAITH IN DIGITAL BABYLON?

*Analog Faith in Digital Babylon* is designed to help church leaders, parents, and local congregations navigate the Digital Age by sharing information and resources that will encourage and strengthen your faith while equipping you to effectively use technology to glorify God.

Solomon was right when he said, "There is nothing new under the sun." While the sins and struggles that impact our lives have been the same since Solomon's day, access to those things is always changing. This workshop will examine how the church should respond to new technology and how we can prepare and equip emerging generations to remain faithful in the Digital Age. We'll discuss topics like Artificial Intelligence, social media, digital addictions, the growing generation gap, and many other ways technology forms and shapes both our lives and our faith.

In the Digital Age, the church must not run from technology. Rather, Christians must learn to steward the tools of our day to effectively "go into all the world" and to "grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ." Join us as we seek to become better digital disciples while wisely guarding against the dangers that exist online.

### *The [Perceived] Generation Gap*

This session examines the events, trends, and innovations that have shaped each generation. Understanding how each generation relates to technology can help us better leverage technology to connect the church and grow God's Kingdom.

### *Analog Consequences to Digital Choices*

Technology is designed to make life easier and more convenient. But with every convenience comes a cost. This session examines many of the ways technology has shaped us spiritually. We'll talk about the impact of social media, digital addictions, and the effect of technology on our mental and spiritual health.

### *Intimacy & Technology*

From the introduction of "the pill" in 1964 to dating apps in the 2000s, our view of sexuality has been directly shaped by technology. This session will examine how unlimited early access to pornography and lustful content has remapped the brain of an entire generation and how defining one's sexuality has become the most important (and controversial) milestone in life. Most importantly, we'll study God's original design and purpose for sexual intimacy and how Christians can cultivate connection while "fleeing youthful lusts." **There will also be a separate class provided for teens during this session.**
